## **Collegiate Training Compass:** Evangelism

<u>What</u>: EDGErs share the gospel with students on campus every week, including times of evaluation and feedback from trainers and teammates.

<u>Why</u>: The gospel is good news...for everyone! EDGE is designed as an opportunity to give focused time to sharing this good news with students (the "E" in EDGE stands for evangelism after all). EDGErs need feedback to grow in their ministry and interpersonal skills.

There's no prescribed method of evangelism for EDGE Corps, but the expectation is that each EDGEr has dozens of stories and a variety of experiences in communicating the gospel with students from all over the spiritual spectrum.

## <u>Questions for your radar</u>:

- Have I observed them sharing the gospel? Given them feedback?
- Who are the non-believers they're relating to?
- Are they a good listener?
- Where do they have resistance to evangelism? Why?
- How is evangelism growing their faith? Character? Interpersonal skills?
