What: Each EDGE staff is helping multiple students come to know and/or grow in Christ and become established in the faith. They work to pass on the vision of multiplication to the students as well.

<u>Why</u>: Multiplying disciplemakers are at the heart of our God-given calling. EDGErs need experience, practice and feedback as they develop the heart and skill to walk alongside others, sparking spiritual generations of laborers who will advance the gospel to the ends of the earth.

We want EDGErs to grow in the skill and conviction of disciple making. Along with evangelism, life-to-life disciple making should make up a large portion of an EDGErs experience. They should finish EDGE Corps having experiences discipling new, growing and established Christians. EDGErs need practice and feedback in this area.

Questions for your radar:

- Is there growing passion in helping people come to know Christ? In establishing believers?
- With whom do they spend most of their time? How are they spending that time?
- Are there gaps in interpersonal skills that limit their effectiveness as a disciple maker?
- Do the students know this EDGEr loves them?
- Is what they're doing passonable?
