<u>What</u>: Each EDGE staff is living out a life of service as they love those they're around with their words and actions.

<u>Why</u>: "By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." John 13:35 As disciples of Jesus, love should characterize us! And our love is developed and expressed through specific acts of service. Trainers get to model and spur EDGErs on toward love and good deeds.

<u>Questions for your radar:</u>

- How often do they talk about themselves? Are others sharpened and encouraged by the way they communicate?
- How can I model service to them?
- What blind spots may be leading to a lack of love?
- How are they serving the students? Staff team? Host family? Community?
- What specific acts of service have I seen them live out and how can I affirm them in that?
